### Erie Presbytery Meeting November 22/2017

Erie Presbytery met November 22/2017 at Scotland United Church. It is one of the few remaining Congregational Churches in Canada]. Cathy Dilts acknowledged that we were on Traditional Territory of First Nations, & we were welcomed by Rev. Art Tobey. Visitors were present. Rev Jeff Smith, Rev. Frank & Margaret Walker, Lori Stetson & I were also present. Worship was led by Cathy Dilts, Kim Shantz & Chris Matheson with the theme" To everything there is a season". Persistent friend Diane Matheson-Jimenez told us Hamilton Conference Meeting is at the Unifor Centre, Port Elgin. Any youth-there will be CAYTS & Youth Forum & now available at the Hamilton Conference Office are Advent Peace Boxes, soap & olive oil to support Palestine/Israel. Aaron Miechkota Coordinator of the Iridesce Living Apology Project will be in the Hamilton Conference Office to book workshops on the apology project. The United Church of Canada is accepting donations for the needs of the Rohingya people. The Canadian Government will match all donations. Barb Fullerton a member of Five Oaks said there are two Muslims & two First Nations also on the board. The business plan is for the centre to be self-sustaining. Matthew Lindsay told us about his trip to Leipzig Germany in June, working as a steward at the world Communion of Reformed Churches with a slide presentation. He thanked Presbytery for their financial support. Rev Randy MacKenzie led us in an overview & voting of Remit 6, vote result was YES & will be passed on to General council. Three members visited the United Church of Canada Archives in Toronto. Scott Wood Band Concert is at St James Dec 7/2017. Jennifer Canning informed us of an interfaith Exchange to be held Wednesday Dec 6 at the Muslim Centre in Brantford on "A Community Against Gender-Based Violence" A vacancy was declared for Delhi UC for 34 time ministry, & presbytery accepted the JNAC of Lynnville UC that will lead to a shared ministry with Delhi UC. Approved was the appointment of Janice Pow, unrecognized designated lay minister in training to KTV United Church part time. Erie Presbytery recommended Robert Lawson[Harmony UC] for Ordination May 2018. There are only four students at present, two inquiers & a DLM & only two candidates for ordination from Hamilton Conference. A LLWL workshop was held at Five Oaks in the fall. Recommendations for the distribution of assets of the Balfour U.C. The draft budget was accepted. Erie Presbytery will continue to support the transitional phase of Grand River Spiritual & Educational Resources. Hamilton Conference raised \$2,874,101 for M&S in 2016. A thank you poster was given to each congregation which I will put on bulletin board.
