### Return to in person Worship Service COVID Guidelines, September 5, 2021

1. Before deciding to attend church, perform a self-screen at home answering the following questions: [https://covid-19.ontario.ca/covid19-cms-assets/2021-08/EN\\_Patron\\_Screening\\_v8-21-08-27%20FINAL.pdf](https://covid-19.ontario.ca/covid19-cms-assets/2021-08/EN_Patron_Screening_v8-21-08-27%20FINAL.pdf)
2. Upon entering the church, wear a mask ( unless you have permission not to as a result of a medical condition or are being accommodated through the accessibility act)
3. Sanitize your hands
4. Record your name on the contact tracing sheet
5. Do your best to maintain a social distance of 6 feet from other members of the congregation, who are not part of your household
6. Take your seat in a pew that has been identified with a cross
7. If you are sitting alone or with a member of your household or bubble, you may remove your mask during the worship service
8. During the service, you are welcome to hum or say the words to a hymn. Singing is only permitted behind the Plexiglas partition in the choir loft.
9. Following the service, replace your mask and leave the sanctuary attempting to maintain a social distance of 6 feet from others

We understand that being part of the Woodhouse congregation involves socializing with others before and after the worship service. To help us follow the health regulations, it is important to wear a mask if you cannot maintain a social distance of 6 feet. Once you are outdoors, you are allowed to remove your mask.
